# Lumpur, Penang Island & Singapore



### Day 1 Arrival Kuala Lumpur

The tour then takes you on a meandering drive around the island passing by fruit orchards an quaint villages. We'll stop at a fruit stall where we'll show you a variety of tropical fruits harvested locally. Finally, visit the island's famous Snake

Temple. It is filled with the smoke of burning incense and a variety of pit vipers. Though they are believed to be rendered harmless by the incense, they have been devenom just to be on the safe side.

# Day 5 Penang – Singapore (B)
